Authenticity and Vulnerability in Pastoral Ministry

In my November and December Voice articles I wrote extensively on authenticity. For November, I spoke about trying to be our authentic selves. I revealed some character traits about myself to let you learn more about who I am as a child of God. I invited you to do the same with those whom you are close with or if the Spirit inspired you, to do so with me. For December, I followed up by inviting all of us to re-discover the authentic Jesus Christ by participating in a challenge to read one of the four Gospels before attending Christmas Eve Worship. Janet also worked diligently to daily post to ALC's Facebook page one chapter from the Gospel of Luke.

After writing about authenticity for two months, I chose to be vulnerable in my Christmas Eve Sermon. I preached about the struggles I had trying to balance academics and social life in my undergrad. While it was not explicitly stated, it was inferred that I prioritized social life over academics. The result of this decision led to me failing 3 classes in my undergrad. This led to another series of decisions; withdrawing from college; working at Menards; becoming a CNA; being fired and eventually going back to college, all while trying to discern how God was at work.

By virtue of my vocation as a pastor, I am afforded the opportunity to theologically interpret passages from Holy Scripture each week through the public proclamation of a sermon. Thus, there are times when not only I but pastors in general, choose to share something about ourselves publicly from the pulpit to further interpret the Gospel for our contemporary lives. Pastors do so in an effort to create an entry point for our parishioners. When these vulnerable stories are shared in such a public way, many times someone who has never walked into pastor's office shows up because they heard (maybe for the first time) that their pastor is also a human being who has struggles just like the rest of the congregation. (P.S. You are welcome here.)

So, if you hear me preaching or teaching about something that is vulnerable and reveals something authentic about my life or character, it's never done in a way to say "Oh, look at me." It always done from a place of humility in an effort to invite you into our shared ministry here at American Lutheran Church. In the end, it allows us to walk alongside one another and reveal the ways God is working in our lives. Thus. promise by the Spirit's leading, to "tend the flock of God that is in [my] charge, exercising the oversight, not under compulsion but willingly, as God would have [me] do it—not for sordid gain but eagerly. [I will] not lord it over those in [my] charge, but [will] be an example to the flock." (1 Peter 5:2-3)


